A Little Girl's Will to Live ~ Meet Izzie!

Little Izzie, an adorable little 4-month-old, Feist mix, was abandoned in Marble, NC. LRR said "yes" immediately to saving her through Logan's Run Rescue's adoption program. As a little foster waiting for her "fix" date and her future family, she was a bundle of joy---so young and frisky with the brightest of futures. With everyone she met, it was instant "mushy love!" Izzie is just one of those incredible little bundles of joy to be with.



On Friday, February 11th, 3 days after her "fix" date, Izzie was brutally attacked by a large dog while in foster care, over food being left with no supervision. Her foster called Lynne Wilson, who made arrangements for her to immediately go to Lake Chatuge Animal Hospital. Izzie was in shock and spent 4 days in intensive care before she was stabilized.

On Tuesday, it was decided to operate, and it was during surgery that the degree of her injuries were fully realized. Izzie had suffered an abdominal hernia, a lacerated diaphragm, her bowel was lacerated in two places, (one of which could be sutured and repaired and the other had to be resected and repaired), two fractured ribs, and multiple puncture wounds.

LRR's medical committee made the life and death decision to try to save her. Sometimes you just do what you have to do in rescue work and worry about the funds later. We did our best to save Izzie! And this incredible dog was the biggest fighter of all She held on no matter what the odds!

Dr. Burr has suggested that Izzie become LRR's mascot; for we at Logan's Run Rescue will never give up until every pet has a home!

On December 15, 2009, along a rural Georgia highway late in the day, LRR member Gail Sikes spotted an abandoned dog, looking to the passing cars for help! She could not continue driving without stopping to investigate, and then realized the dog was hurt. Gail looked for neighbors and there were none. She considered her options for a moment and did the only thing she could – took the dog home with her! That's when "Copper" entered Logan's Run Rescue and was given a chance for a new life.

Thanks to your donations, money was available to cover medical exams. His spine has a hump in it from either a birth defect or possibly an old accident. He can walk but hops when running or when tired. He needs daily Rimadyl (a pain-killer) and glucosamine soft chews to live a normal life. The cost is about \$500 a year and is still covered by LRR, even after the dog has been adopted. A special foster home was needed for Copper; one who would take the time for Copper to gain healing strength ... and the chance to become all he was born to be.

Sonny and Bill Smith of Marble volunteered to foster Copper. During 2010, they renamed him "Precious" and he became a very special dog; a happy, handsome young, red heeler. Sonny & Bill's other rescued pet, Angel, a treeing Walker Hound, gained a canine friend to play with. She lovingly tolerates Precious's tendency to herd her. The Smiths contacted Logan's Run Rescue in 2011 with the greatest news ever ~ they wished to adopt Precious.

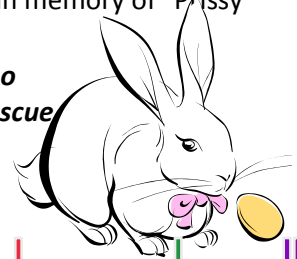

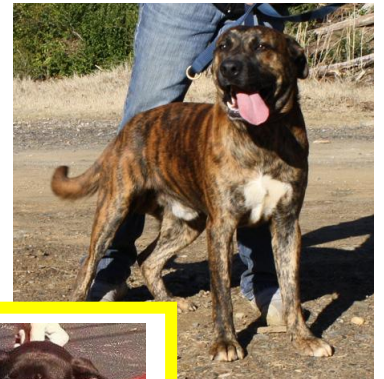
The Easter Bunny... ...Simplified

It creates anxiety every year. Should you get the children an Easter bunny or chick? Deep down you know it's a disaster in the making!

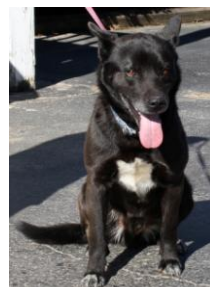
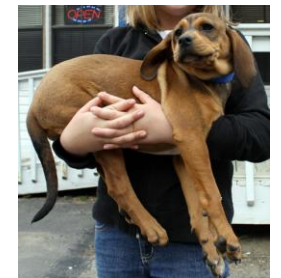
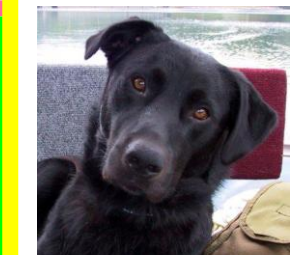
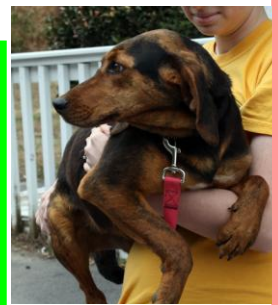
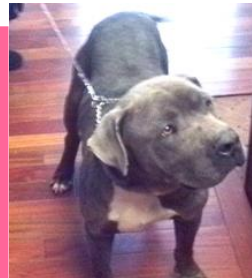
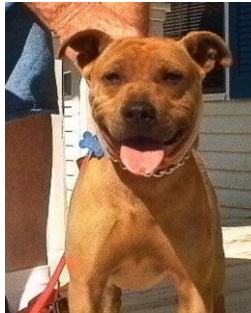

A Warm Home for CC

The little dog who was eventually named “CC” was noticed hanging around an abandoned home for days, as NC braced for a winter storm. The second night that single digits were predicted, her rescuers finally convinced this scared, little girl to trust them. CC had found the first love of her early life, even though she didn’t know it yet.

Not only was CC emaciated and nearly starved, she had breasts full of milk, indicating she had recently delivered pups. Relentless searches and attempts, despite the winter storms, never discovered the pups. The heroes/rescuers had worked with Logan’s Run Rescue before and knew that we would help. The vets determined that CC was most likely less than 2 years old and this was at least her 3rd litter. She had also survived distemper some time during her short life; a disease that is totally preventable with vaccines.

Before CC left LRR for her new family, she had been fully vetted and spayed through LRR, and proudly wore current rabies tags.

CC is one of LRR’s success stories and personifies why we formed our organization.

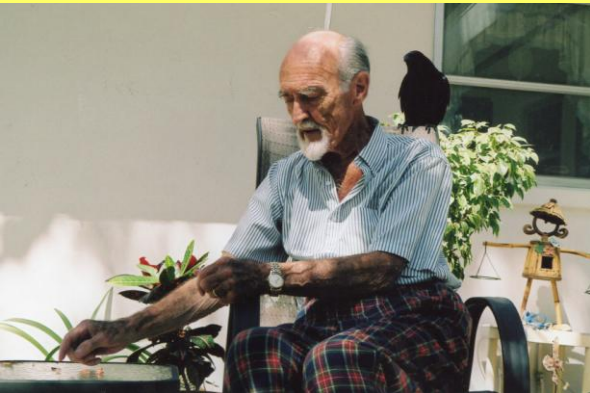

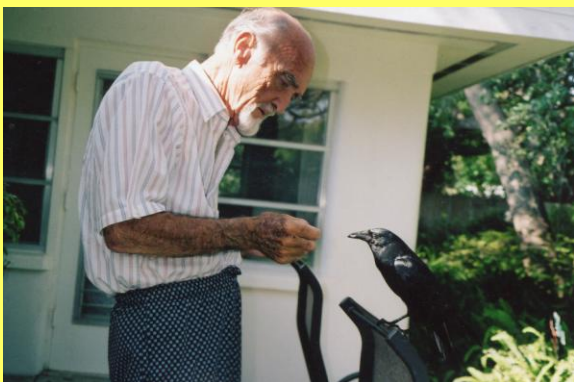
One of my most profound memories of Dad happened when I was in Jr. High School. While walking together, enjoying the day, I jumped up and grabbed a handful of green leaves off a tree. I’ll never forget my shock when receiving a “death stare” from Dad ~ and he was really talented at death stares! I grasped he was displeased with the killing of the leaves, but I didn’t know why. I inquired and he simply responded, “It was Unnecessary!”

My father had a deep respect for life and adroitly took advantage of his displeasure to successfully pass that on ~ for the lesson has never left me. Through the years, he and Mom taught me how to be a responsible pet owner by having them fixed and loyally caring for them until their passing.

My father’s love for God’s animals turned my parent’s homeplace into a menagerie of wild animals he took care of and quite often befriended. I’ll let the picture expand your vision!

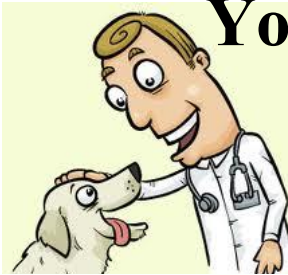
