DEATH OF A CAREGIVER

2% to 3% of the animals surrendered to shelters are relinquished due to the death or disability of their human caregivers. "Orphaned" pets do not adjust well to shelter life. Tag Your Dogs.....It's Easy and SO Worth It !!!

In the last three weeks, I've had encounters with three stray dogs; two wearing collars with no tags and one without a collar at all. These dogs had all been hanging around a neighborhood where they didn't belong for several days before I got the call about them. They were fairly healthy looking and all appeared to have been someone's lost pet. We took the dogs to a local vet to have them scanned for a microchip and to see if the vet recognized them. We drove around neighborhoods, carrying the dogs, asking neighbors if anyone recognized them. We called the sheriff's office to report finding the dogs. In all, we went through a lot of work to try to find the dogs' owners.....all without any success.

Why? **All because someone's pet got lost while not wearing tags.**

Every time I come across a lost pet without tags I just want to scream, "Come on people...tag your dogs!! How hard can it be?!!!" WalMart has a tag-making machine, local hardware stores have engraving machines, you can order tags online in every shape and size.

Logan's Run Rescue offers dog tags for \$3.00 each. Just provide this information: Pet's Name, two phone numbers & address. Drop off this information at our All 4 The Paws Thrift Store in Murphy, NC or contact LRR's tag maker, Ron Stoessel, ronstoessel@gmail.com or 828-644-1898.

The poor puppy spent four days in intensive care at Lake Chatuge Animal Hospital before having surgery for an abdominal hernia, a lacerated diaphragm, a lacerated bowel, two fractured ribs, and multiple puncture wounds. We did our best to save Izzie! And this incredible dog was the biggest fighter of all ... She held on no matter what the odds!

There Are Angels Among Us

The story of the three Morgan pups (Barney, Baxter, and Bailey) is typical of so many litters in Cherokee County, NC. Their mother, "Hope," is a white, American bulldog mix that was abandoned in a fenced yard with her litter, along with an Alaskan husky. The owners left for two months, leaving the dogs to starve or die of thirst. However, Mrs. Morgan, a kind-hearted neighbor released them, providing food and water, and brought the 8-week-old puppies into Logan's Run's "Stray & Pet Assistance Program" (SPAP) on 2/24/11. The pups are very handsome: two brindles and a black with white chest, but they and their mom had demodex mange. Mrs. Morgan couldn't foster the dogs inside her house, and the puppies needed to be separated from their mother to treat the mange, so Ron Stoessell, an LRR member, took responsibility for the pups and arranged for Gayle and Dennis Ramsay to foster them and treat their mange while Mrs. Morgan treated Hope's.



Because of their mange, the puppies couldn't go to the Atlanta Humane Society for adoption, and by the time they were well, they were too old for Atlanta, so they needed a new foster. Birgit O'Driscoll and Rose Gould fostered them for a week, until Ron could take them in with his own pets for house training while looking for adoptive homes or rescues.

Two years ago, Sindee Hurlock, adopted Bill from Logan's Run. LRR had paid for a bone marrow transplant to save Bill's leg. Through the Logan's Run website, Sindee found the two brindle pups, for her friends, Anita and Dale Curley, in Canada, and on April 30, the Curleys drove down to Pennsylvania from Ontario and met Ron, who drove up from North Carolina, to adopt Baxter and Bailey. Everything went well in the adoption. Anita and Dale have raised German shepherds in the past and are dog people.

Ron now has Barney, the handsome black and white puppy, living with his pack of older dogs, and is looking for a good home for him. **Barney will be a great family dog, fully vetted and micro-chipped, likes cats, other dogs, and loves people and children. He is about 30 pounds now, and we think he will be 60 pounds when fully grown. He is house-trained, sits on command, and learns easily. And this boy is so affectionate. He loves to cuddle and wants to sleep in your arms!** ♦.....→

The mama dog, Hope, was fixed on 5/5/11 in the LRR SNAP program – so no more litters for her! Love & Care For Her Final Days --- Natalie's Story

Natalie, a little terrier that looks like a fox, lived tied to a tree for months until the owner moved away, leaving her abandoned and still tied to the tree. A neighbor reported the situation to Logan's Run Rescue.

Natalie is 10-12 years old. When rescued, she had bronchitis, infected ears and a tumor located on her back leg. The tumor was positive for sarcoma and the vets believe she may have leukemia as well. This is how Natalie became Logan's Run Rescue's first hospice case.

He and his wife, Marian, could not stand by and allow Natalie to face the end of life without love and care, so they volunteered to serve as Natalie's health care directors and foster parents.

Now Natalie spends her days surrounded by Waylon and Marian's wonderful family, receiving the love she so rightly deserves. And Natalie is like a sponge ~ soaking up all this love she would not have received if not for Waylon and Marian. When Natalie's time comes, she will cross the rainbow bridge leaving lessons for us humans. Sometimes being humane means loving and nurturing while nature completes the circle of life.
